## RELEASE

To our customers, travel trade partners, staff and community members,

Inukpak Outfitting is taking the COVID-19 situation seriously. We are continuously monitoring the global and Canadian situations and especially the situation in the Arctic, where we offer guided adventures and tourism-related programs. The health and safety of our Nunavut communities, guests and staff is, and remain, our top priority. Inukpak outfitting is proud to do our part in keeping people safe. Be assured that we are taking all the precautionary measures and that we follow national, territorial and local Public Health agency recommendations.

In order to offer safe excursion to the public, as well as a safe work environment for our staff, Inukpak Outfitting is implementing additional safety measures:

\*To participate, recipients must agree to abide by public health guidelines and Inukpak Outfitting's safety rules. Those rules and guidelines may change from time to time.

- Face masks are mandatory in enclosed spaces (ex: office and vehicle to get to activity location); once outdoor, they are not mandatory.  
\*Participants must provide their own face mask
- Additional washing and disinfection of office, vehicles and rental equipment (we strongly encourage guests to use their own equipment, more specifically harder-to-clean gear, i.e. snowmobile helmet and goggles)
- Guests and staff will be requested to wash hands regularly. Hand sanitizer will be available and be mandatory in the office and before handling food.
- Implementation of a new menu for our trail snacks (individually wrapped snacks will now be offered to our guests).
- All programs, training and expeditions in all communities are currently on-going (this may change without notice).
- Programs that require people to spend time in close proximity (ex: sleeping in a cabin, igloo, tent) are currently on-going (this may change without notice).
- To participate after travelling, recipients must wear a mask for at least 14 days while in Nunavut.

As for the limitations due to covid-19, each traveler must apply themselves, to our Government of Nunavut Public Health department, two weeks prior to their trip, to obtain an "exemption from isolation" letter. The letter is given under proof of Canadian approved double vaccination + two weeks after the second dose. Once you receive it, you must show it at the airline prior to your flight along with your vaccination proof and government issued ID's. The Inukpak Outfitting team asks all guests to help us slow down this worldwide situation. Guest who have signs and symptoms and/or that have been in contact with someone that is showing signs and symptoms or is currently in self-isolation due to COVID-19 should refrain from coming to the activity and contact us to cancel or postpone their booking. Inukpak Outfitting will handle each case individually, offering additional flexibility within the existing Cancellation Policy. \*Inukpak Outfitting reserves the right to turn away any guests who show signs and symptoms similar to those of COVID-19.

Under these circumstances, please understand that bookings for any of our activities that entail traveling from outside of Nunavut may change without notice. Rest assured that we continue to monitor the situation, and that we commit ourselves to respond to any new developments.
